The position will review, trend, report and interpret population health data, including clinical outcomes, to identify opportunities for improvement on program, financial, quality, & patient experience.

Responsibilities include the evaluation and analysis of healthcare utilization and outcome data using Excel, Cognos or any other business intelligence tools. Working with our partner clinics, the Analyst will automate import/export features between EMR & disease registries, deploy population health &/or care management modules to help with empanelment, risk stratification and quality improvement activities and develop reports and dashboards to accurately track clinical outcome measures and demographic data.

The Analyst will design and develop reports from various data sources, identify, analyze, and interpret trends or patterns in complex data sets, and communicate complex ideas via all communication venues. Ensure that all reports and analyses are accurate, complete, and produced within the required deadlines.
