

Out of Network Insurance. If the doctor, hospital or health care facility you visit is part of your insurance company's network, you'll get your health care at lower prices. But if you go out of your network for health care, it can become a lot more expensive. If you have an HMO or EPO plan, you'll usually pay all costs for care you get outside of your plan's network. It's important to carefully consider which doctors and hospitals are in a plan's network before you choose that service.

Alcoholics Anonymous

Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) is an international fellowship of men and women who have had a drinking problem. It is nonprofessional, self-supporting, multiracial, apolitical, and available almost everywhere. There are no age or education requirements. Membership is open to anyone who wants to do something about his or her drinking problem.

A.A. members share their experience with anyone seeking help with a drinking problem; they give person-to-person service or "sponsorship" to the alcoholic coming to A.A. from any source. The A.A. program, set forth in our Twelve Steps, offers the alcoholic a way to develop a satisfying life without alcohol.

A.A. members may be asked to conduct the informational meetings about A.A. as a part of A.S.A.P. (Alcohol Safety Action Project) and D.W.I. (Driving While Intoxicated) programs. These meetings *about A.A.* are *not* regular A.A. group meetings.

There are different types of AA meetings:

Open (O) speaker meetings — open to alcoholics and nonalcoholics.

(Attendance at an open A.A. meeting

is the best way to learn what A.A. is, what it does, and what it does not do.) At speaker meetings, A.A. members "tell their stories." They describe their experiences with alcohol, how they came to A.A., and how their lives have changed as a result of Alcoholics Anonymous

Open (O) discussion (D) meetings — one member speaks briefly about his or her drinking experience, and then leads a discussion on A.A. recovery or any drinking-related problem anyone brings up.

Closed (C) discussion (D) meetings — conducted just as open discussions are, but for alcoholics or prospective A.A. members only.

Step meetings (usually closed) — discussion of one of the Twelve Steps.

The Center for Mental Health (CMH) has provided behavioral health services in Delta, Gunnison, Hinsdale, Montrose, Ouray, and San Miguel Counties since 1964.

The CMH is committed to providing opportunities for growth and change that promote health and well-being in the communities they serve. CMH provides the following services:

- Individual therapy for all ages
- Group therapy
- Substance use disorder therapy
- 24-hour, no-cost emergency services

For individual and group therapy, appointments can be scheduled by phone or on-site. Once you schedule an appointment, you will go through a required intake process, which includes filling out papers and answering a series of questions. This helps CMH provide the best care possible for your individual situation. Intake appointments take about two hours.

The CMH uses an income-based sliding fee scale for self-pay clients. CMH also takes most third-party insurance and self-paying clients. CMH accepts Medicaid.



The Center has a dedicated emergency services team available to respond to emergency calls in all six counties, 24-hours a day, 7-days a week. Crisis intervention, suicide/homicide risk assessment, emergency mental health and alcohol commitments, and debriefings are among the services provided. Emergency services are available at no cost. Their number is: 970.252.6220.

Individual therapy appointments will take an hour. Group therapy can

take up to an hour and a half. For some services, such as psychiatric evaluations, there are short wait times before an appointment is scheduled.
