JOB SUMMARY:

Under the general direction of the Community Health Programs Manager, the Tri-County Health Network (TCHNetwork) Regional Health Connector (RHC) is responsible for supporting local community health improvement efforts by building linkages among the various components of the healthcare system, including primary care, behavioral health, and organizations that address the social determinants of health.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

May include the following, and other duties as assigned.

- 1. Support TCHNetwork in launching an innovative, new rural transportation partnership with Lyft, including acting as driver when needed
- 2. Increase access to healthy, locally grown food through the development and implementation of a healthy food prescription program at local clinics
- 3. In collaboration with regional stakeholders, create a standardized mental health crisis triage process, distribute it to stakeholders and organizations across the region, and support partners in expanding their co-responder program
- 4. Build relationships with primary care practices, informing them of available resources to develop new models of care delivery and compensation
- 5. Encourage relationships between research and community, helping to identify mutual interests and potential partnerships
- 6. Provide assistance and input into developing strategies for practice recruitment, enrollment, and retention into community health programs
- 7. Increase understanding of shared community health interests as well as the value of health and health care research
- 8. Provide education about practice transformation opportunities
- 9. Serve as liaison between physician offices, public health, and community organizations
- 10. Advocate for social and cultural awareness within practices and other program staff
- 11. Link practices to relevant resources and support services and leverage available projects, programs, and resources

EDUCATIONAL AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

Bachelor's Degree in health care administration, public health, public affairs, human services, social work or similar field.
